RE: NON-HAZARDOUS MAGNETIC MATERIAL

Thank you for purchasing Magnum Magnetics products. We value each of our customers and appreciate your business. We know there are choices in magnetic products, and we are happy to be your provider.

Our flexible magnetic sheet material does not meet the definition of hazardous material per IATA 3.9.2.2, which defines a magnetic material as any package with a magnetic field of or greater than 0.002 gauss measured at 2.1 m (7 feet) from any surface of the package.

Our magnetic material also does not exceed the magnetic field limit set forth by the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 49 section 173.21 (d), which states; for carriage by aircraft, any package which has a magnetic field of or greater than 0.00525 gauss measured at 4.5 m (15 feet) from any surface of the package.
